



## Entrance exam – General Information

In order to sit the entrance exam you will need:

- computer with a functioning Google Chrome browser (the online tools should work well in all main web browsers but Google Chrome is probably the best one)
- functioning web camera and a microphone
- good network connection
- your passport or other ID card

You can also print out periodic table of elements with the atomic weight of elements.

## Before the exam

Access the main link: <http://prijimacky.inis.lf3.cuni.cz/info/>, which will lead you to the testing platform, the ZOOM meeting, your results and general information.

You will find there the access to the testing platform. Once you log in you will see a “course” named “*Entrance exam, date*”. Please click on the one with appropriate date to enter the testing environment.

You will find a section with important general information about the entrance exam and practice test - we urge you to complete it well before the exam takes place.

- There are only four questions in the Practice Test, each on a separate page. Choose the option you think is correct and continue to the next one. If you want to go back to a previous question, click on the “Previous page” below the question. Once you’ve answered the last question the test will give you the option to return to the attempt and change your answers or submit the test. By submitting the test you complete it and can finish. The test will submit itself and close automatically 1 hour after you start it (the real entrance exam test will do the same after 2 hours), you can see the timer on the right side of the test. You can play around with the Practice test as you like to learn how to work in the testing environment.
- Completing the practice tests tells us you have no technical problems with the testing platform and can proceed to the entrance exam test. Do not worry, your answers to the practice test will have no effect on your entrance exam scores, however, not completing it may complicate the ensuing procedures.



## **The Exam**

On the day of your entrance exam you will need to log into the testing platform (please do it approximately 15 minutes before the exam starts to avoid problems) and also connect to the ZOOM meeting using the main link. When prompted, you must allow the teleconference software to use your camera and microphone. This teleconference link will allow us to communicate with you during the exam and also monitor your behavior to prevent cheating.

The entrance exam is in two rounds:

- First is a written (electronic) test in Biology and Chemistry.

In the online test always exactly one option is correct and there are no negative points for an incorrect answer. You will have in total 2 hours to complete the test. You may go back to your previous answers and correct them until the end of the testing time. You may not use any other devices or books (including your notes) and of course, you are not allowed to ask anyone for assistance. We will observe you the whole time of the exam through a teleconference using your computer's camera and microphone. Any attempt at cheating will result in failing your entrance exam and the inability to enroll in the medical programme of the Third Faculty of Medicine.

Within 30 minutes after the last candidate has finished writing, you will be informed on the main link whether you have successfully passed the written part and are proceeding to the second part and when exactly it will be. The interview will take place on the same day as the written part of the exam.

- The interview will be done via the ZOOM meeting. It includes an interpretation of a popular - scientific text, general overview and communication skills

## **After the exam**

The official decision on admission will be sent to you after the submission of your high-school leaving certificate.

We very much hope that you will successfully pass the entrance exam and come in September to start fulfilling your dream of becoming a doctor at the Third Faculty of Medicine in Prague.
