The most used databases

Amboss

Amboss - factual portal of study materials in the field of medicine ([more information](#))

UpToDate

UpToDate – a database that contains information about:

- drug interactions
- patient management (how to communicate diagnoses to different types of patients, how to discuss treatment plans with patients, etc.)
- calculators and calculations

Evidence-Based Medicine Reviews (EBMR)

Evidence-Based Medicine Reviews (EBMR) – a set of databases that provide a comprehensive basis for research and decision-making for evidence-based medicine (*a systematic approach to treatment that integrates the best available scientific evidence with the clinical experience of the physician and with the preferences and needs of the patient being treated*). It collects and synthesizes research from a variety of sources, including systematic reviews and clinical trials, so that the results help physicians and researchers stay up to date on the latest approaches in their fields

Databases of records of articles and other publications in the field of medicine

PubMed®

PubMed® is a free, searchable bibliographic database (a database of records about a book, article, etc., containing information such as author, title, year of publication, abstract, and more) of the National Library of Medicine® (NLM) of the United States that supports scientific and medical research. It contains more than 38 million bibliographic citations and abstracts of articles from the biomedical and biological literature.

MEDLINE

A subset of PubMed is [MEDLINE](#) (Medical Literature Analysis and Retrieval System Online), the largest database of bibliographic records in public health, clinical care, nursing, dentistry, preclinical sciences, and other medical fields. It contains records of articles from 5,200 professional journals in 40 languages. Both databases include click-throughs for full texts for some articles.

Web of Science

[Web of Science](#) (WoS) is an international bibliographic and citation database covering thousands of scientific journals, a large collection of books and conference proceedings across disciplines. Information about publications is available including abstracts and cited references. It allows searching and tracking of scientific articles in terms of citations, cited sources, authors or journal impact factor.

Journal Citation Reports

[Journal Citation Reports](#) (JCR) provides a qualitative assessment of scientific journals based on citation responses. It is a source for obtaining bibliometric indicators such as Impact Factor, Immediacy Index, Cited Half-life and many other information.
