The Symposium, which attracts 700 physicians, is an annual professional educational event that provides updates on recent clinical and scientific advances in breast cancer research. The program is an unrivaled opportunity to collaborate with a world-renowned cancer center, to meet breast cancer experts from around the world, and to learn about practical patient care strategies and the exciting possibilities of breast cancer research.

Last year, we had our biggest cohort to date, and we are hopeful that this year we will have representatives from each of our sister cities!
