Dear colleagues,

In order to develop cooperation and promotion of scientific and educational exchanges between Belgorod State National Research University (BelSU) and Charles University in Prague we ask you to consider the possibility of concluding cooperation agreement, subject of which could be:

- a) development of various forms of networking concerning master and doctoral training in the field of Basic medicine. Pharmacology, clinical pharmacology;
- b) organization of summer international schools, seminars, conferences, symposiums;
- c) establishment of laboratory and regulatory framework for conducting joint research, and simultaneous training doctoral students both at BelSU and Charles University in Prague in the field of Basic medicine. Pharmacology, clinical pharmacology;
- d) expansion of experimental research opportunities;
- e) development of academic mobility programs, including scientific internships;
- f) international teacher's training.

The Belgorod State National Research University has the capacity to carry out research in the field of the comparative bioequivalence of medicinal substances, the first phase of clinical researches. There is a pharmacokinetic laboratory with robotic sample preparation, HPLC with a UV and mass spectrometric detector.

At the same time we have possibilities for preclinical studies of pharmacokinetics in laboratory animals, including distribution in organs and tissues.

The university has a laboratory for preclinical studies of medicinal agents in a wide range of pharmacological activities. Several scientific groups work on preclinical studies - cardiac pharmacology, pharmacology of isolated organs, behavior pharmacology, electrophysiology and toxicology.

We hope for close and mutually beneficial cooperation.
