Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible to apply to SUMS Medical Elective Programs, the applicant must satisfy the succeeding conditions:

- The candidate must be a medical student.
- The candidate should not be a graduate.
- The candidate must be in their final or penultimate year of study of their medical degree, as students are expected to have done some clinical training before they can undertake an elective placement at SUMS.
- The candidate must be a non-Iranian or Iranian student enrolled in a non-Iranian university, or be an international student studying in an Iranian university.

When to Apply

SUMS call for application to Medical Elective Programs is open all year round. However, candidates are encouraged to apply at least 6 to 8 months prior to the commencement of the program in order to avoid late visa issues.

Accommodation

SUMS supplies medical elective candidates with furnished accommodation provided that vacancies are available at SUMS residence halls. Moreover, the fee is 300.00 USD per month.






